The Fine Arts Fiesta (FAF) is the oldest arts festival in 'A. More than 50,000 people attend the four-day free event in downtown Wilkes-Barre.

Back-to-back performances, exciting exhibits and a lelicious array of ethnic foods ensure a steady flow of reople from the Northeast to your booth.

Eligibility

The FAF is open to all artists and craftspeople 18 years of age and older who create original work. No commercial molds, kit objects, decoupage, prenanufactured components, etc. will be considered. urors and the FAF reserve the right to determine the ligibility of all objects submitted for jurying. The FAF ttempts to show a reasonable number of each of the fine rts and crafts.

Fhe Artists' Breakfast

All exhibitors will receive an invitation to the free oreakfast for Saturday morning on **May 20, 2023**. Cost or additional guests for the breakfast is TBD.

Awards

Cash awards are presented for Best of Show in Fine Arts, Crafts, along with Honorable Mentions in each category It the Judge's discretion at <u>The Artists' Breakfast</u>.

Fees

Upon acceptance, a <u>\$200</u> exhibition fee and <u>\$30</u> W-B license fee to FAF is required by **April 6**, 2023. Late payments are not accepted. Exhibit fees are non-refundable after **April 15**, 2023.

Exhibition Space and Provisions

Exhibitors must supply their own 10' x 10' tents and lights. FAF provides 110V electricity, water and comfort facilities. Exhibitors must keep their area clean. Laptops cannot be plugged into the power source.

Lodging

Exhibitors', who live outside a 60-mile radius of FAF, are provided a subsidized single-occupancy hotel room in close proximity to the event on Public Square. Hotel rooms are on a first come first serve basis for Thurs., Fri. and Sat. night for a total of <u>\$200</u>(Payable to FAF by **April 6, 2023**). Reservations will be made by FAF for your hotel rooms and a reservation number will be provided to you. Contact information for the hotel will also be provided for anyone needing to book a room for additional nights at your own expense.

Demonstrations

We encourage exhibitors to demonstrate.

Security

FAF provides security from close until opening each day. Exhibitors acknowledge they are responsible for the care of their own work and display and that neither Luzerne County, the city of Wilkes-Barre, or FAF are responsible for the loss or damage of any works or display in the show or in overnight storage.

Parking

Free parking off Public Square is provided.

Applications must be postmarked by **February 17, 2023**. If pre-juried, a processing fee of <u>\$25</u> must be included.

Notification of acceptance or rejection will be provided to you the week of **March 4, 2023**. The decision of the judges is final.
